[Alta](#) and [Snowbird](#) - Two world-class resorts, tucked away in Utah's Little Cottonwood Canyon, on a single lift ticket. The [Cliff Lodge](#) - Snowbird's premiere ski-in/ski-out property. Our vacation coincides with Snowbird's Powderfest ski-club week which includes

[Alta](#) - Deep powder, a variety of terrain, and spectacular scenery make Alta world renowned. Its best-kept secret is the great beginner and intermediate terrain. Perennially ranked No. 1 for Best Snow (500-inch annual average) in Ski Magazine's reader resort survey. 2,020 feet of continuously skiable vertical, from the 8,530-ft base to the 10,550-ft summit. 2,200 skiable acres of terrain and 116 trails (25% rated beginner, 40% intermediate, 35% advanced/expert).

[Snowbird](#) - 3,240 feet of vertical from the 7,760-ft base to the 11,000-ft summit. 2,500 acres of terrain and 89 trails (27% rated beginner, 38% intermediate, 35% advanced/expert) blessed by 500 inches average annual snowfall (ranked No. 2 for Best Snow, right behind Alta).

***Skiing:*** Our trip includes a 6-day interchangeable lift ticket good at both resorts. This is a special Powderfest package and there is no discount or deduction for seniors or non-skiers. However, since snowboards are not permitted at Alta, you may deduct \$100 from the trip price if you prefer a Snowbird-only lift ticket.



***Lodging:*** Our 7-night stay will be in hotel rooms at [Cliff Lodge](#). The Cliff features three restaurants, two lounges, two heated swimming pools, four hot tubs, steam rooms, dry saunas, and an exercise room. On-site facilities include a health & beauty spa, ski rental & repair shop, and laundry facilities. Each room has a hairdryer, coffee maker, and a small refrigerator. All units are non-smoking and have complimentary WiFi Internet access. Price is based on double occupancy; \$595 extra for single occupancy (add \$200 to your initial deposit, \$200 to your interim payment, and \$195 to your final payment).

***Flights:*** We're scheduled to depart **Reagan National Airport** on Delta Airlines at 4:53 p.m. Saturday, January 2, and arrive nonstop in Salt Lake City at 7:36 p.m. We return the following Saturday, January 9, with a 9:50 a.m. departure from Salt Lake City and a 4:03 p.m. nonstop arrival at National. Flight numbers & times are likely to change by the time of our trip; current schedule is available on the [Trip Details](#) page on the club website.

***Signup & Payment Schedule:*** To confirm your place, [sign up online](#) and send the trip leader your deposit (\$400 per person, payable to the Pentagon Ski Club). If you're not yet a club member or if you need to renew, please include a separate check and a membership application. A \$600 interim payment will be due at our October 13 club meeting, and final payments (\$420) will be due at our November 10 club meeting.
