



Valle Nevado, Chile

A Pentagon Ski Club Trip

September 2 – September 12, 2010 (Thurs – Sun): Seven nights in the 4-star, slopeside [Puerta del Sol Hotel](#) at **Valle Nevado** (37 miles from Santiago, Chile’s capital) with daily breakfast and dinner. Free Wi-fi, heated pool, game room, après-ski from 4-6 PM, and cyber café included. Round-trip on Delta from Dulles to Santiago, via Atlanta, plus ground transportation to and from Valle Nevado and Santiago. We will spend additional night at end of trip at [Four Points Sheraton](#) in Santiago for a day of touring. Breakfast is included.

Trip Cost: \$3100/person (based double occupancy). Single supplement is \$750. Includes all flight and ground transportation, lodging, and taxes. Emergency medical & repatriation (*not* cancellation) insurance are part of this package. **7-day lift tickets are included;** also good at **El Colorado** and **La Parva**.
